



## Highlights of the April 2026, Trustees' Meeting

### 1. STRATEGY

- The ASEBP Trustees participated in a strategy readiness session focused on Alberta's healthcare landscape.
- ASEBP remains committed to ensuring that covered members and dependants have a benefits plan that meets their evolving needs, supports their health and well-being, and ensures long-term sustainability.

### 2. PLAN DESIGN – SECOND READING (MYRETIREE PLAN)

- The ASEBP Trustees gave **final approval** (second reading) to Extended Health Care and Dental Care changes for the MyRetiree Plan.
- Please note there were no changes to plan design between the first and second reading, as reflected in the March 2026 Trustees' Report.

### 3. PREMIUM RATES – SECOND READING (MYRETIREE PLAN)

- The ASEBP Trustees gave **final approval** (second reading) to September 1, 2026, premium rates for the **MyRetiree Plan**.
- Please note that there were no changes to MyRetiree Plan premium rates between the first and second reading, as reflected in the March 2026 Trustees' Report.

### 4. RESERVES AND FINANCIAL HEALTH

- Each fiscal year ending December 31, ASEBP must establish regular reserves to:
  - Ensure that promised benefits will be paid in the event of an interruption of premiums or a partial wind-up of a benefit plan; and
  - Reflect the impact of claims in the year in which they occurred.
- The ASEBP Trustees approved the recommended reserve levels from the plan actuary, which will be used to prepare the 2025 audited financial statements.
- The Valuation Report for the year ending December 31, 2025, prepared by the plan actuary, also included a review of the capital adequacy reserve.
- ASEBP continues to meet its financial obligations and balance plan sustainability with the health and wellness needs of covered members and dependants. Overall, ASEBP's financial health remains good.
